# 4'-CL-DESCHLOROALPRAZOLAM FOUND IN EXPECTED BENZO SAMPLES

## A BROKEN WHITE BAR PILL (XANAX PRESS)

found to contain 4'-Cl-deschloroalprazolam, flubromazepam, clobromazolam and ethylbromazolam

## TWO BROWN CAPSULES

found to contain 4'-Cl-deschloroalprazolam

# EFFECTS

4'-Cl-deschloroalprazolam is a new benzo that's been found for the first time at CanTEST in these samples - both by itself and in combination with other benzos. There's little information available about this substance, but it's structurally similar to alprazolam and was first detected in 2021 in both Australia and the USA.

In the white bar (Xanax press) sample, this is the first time that this combination of benzodiazepines have been detected together at CanTEST. This particular combination includes a mixture of long and short acting benzos. In addition to this, flubromazepam can have an onset delay of up to 4 hours, which increases the risk of harm. Anecdotal reports from community members include long periods (up to three days) of blackout and memory loss.
