Alprazolam (or Xanax/Mylan*)

was expected in **3** samples
and detected in **0**.

was expected in **3** samples and

was expected and detected

instead of an expected active drug.

2F-NENDCK

was expected and detected
in **1** sample.

DMT

was expected and detected
in **1** sample.

Pregabalin

was expected and detected
in **2** samples.

LSD

was expected and detected
in **1** sample.

Meth

was expected and detected
in **20** samples.
Purities ranged from **73 - 80%**.

2C-B

was expected and detected
in **4** samples.
Purity for 1 sample was **<5%**

Ketamine

was expected in **39** samples and
detected in **38**.
Purities ranged from **16 - 87%**
1 sample also contained
MDMA (<5%)

Heroin

was expected and detected
in **6** samples.
Purities ranged from **38 - 80%**.
1 sample also contained
6-MAM and **acetylcodeine**,

Cocaine

was expected in **34** samples and
detected in **30**.
Purities ranged from **16 - 87%**
Where **cocaine** was expected but
not detected, **1** sample
contained **ketamine (80%)**

MDMA

was expected in **95** samples,
detected in **88**.
Samples tested & their purity ranges:
20/20 capsules contained **64 - 84%**
16/22 pills contained **<5 - 43%**
3/3 powders contained **42 - 68%**
49/50 crystalline contained **32 - 84%**
2 pills also contained **MDA (9 - 15%)**,
and **1** crystalline sample also
contained **ketamine (<5%)**
Where **MDMA** was expected
but wasn't found:
2 pills contained **MDA (14 - 20%)**

CanTEST have tested a total of **6472**
samples to 20th March 2026.

We provided **227** health and AOD brief
interventions and **10/225** samples
were voluntarily discarded by people
after they received their results.

CanTEST extended its hours ahead of Digi Festival (CBR, Sat 28 Feb),

opening for 12 hrs total instead of 6.
A yellow notice was issued on 27 Feb
(expected MDMA/detected MDMA &
MDA) ahead of the event, reflecting
recent reports from NSW & VIC.

While MDA has been detected at
CanTEST previously, this is the first
time we've issued it as a notice.

Directions Health's CanTEST partners,
CAHMA & Pill Testing Australia
were each at Digi, delivering a peer-
based harm reduction tent and
onsite drug checking.

Between 26-28 Feb, across the
CanTEST fixed site and PTA's onsite
service, **296 people accessed drug**
checking, presenting 275 samples,
and 7 public notices were issued:

1 high-risk detection onsite at
the event (expected cocaine/detected
heroin) and
5 additional yellow notices at Digi,
and the 27 Feb MDA notice.
